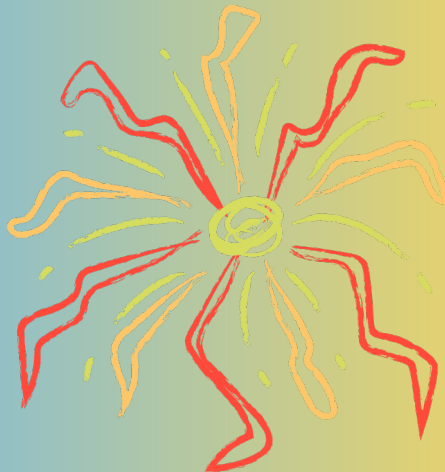

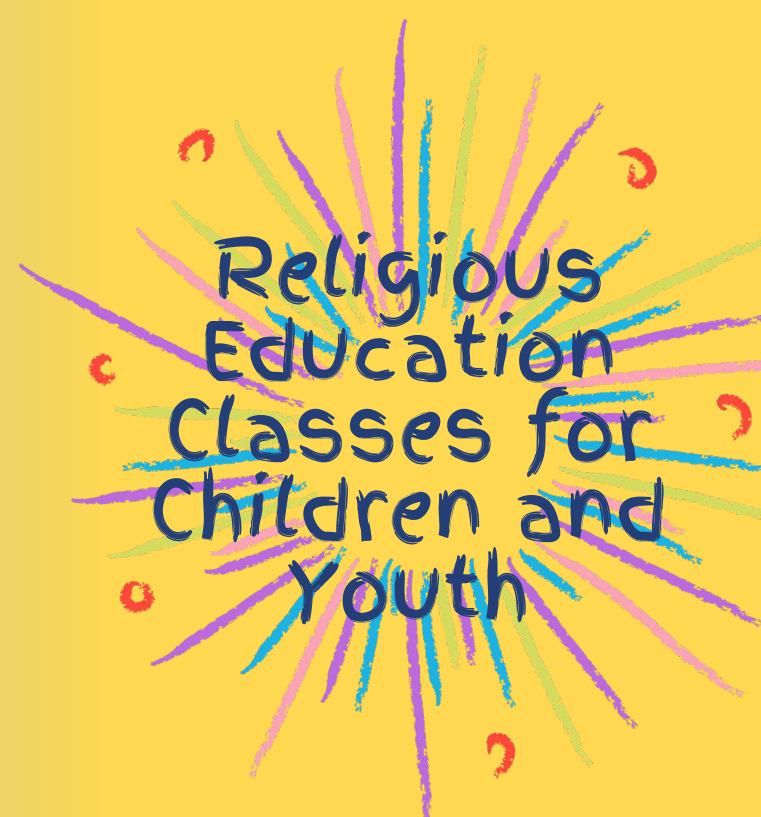

Grades 1-3

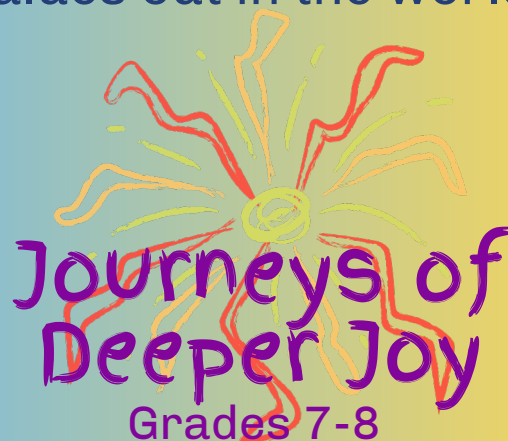

Youth Group

Grades 9-12
